**To be eligible to receive the scholarship, the applicant must:** (a) be a Johnston County High School graduate; (b) have a minimum 2.75 GPA; (c) have a minimum SAT Score of 1200 or ACT Composite of 26 or better; (d) be pursuing an undergraduate degree from an accredited college, university, or community college; and (e) present evidence of official matriculation at the institution from the office of the registrar.

**A complete application packet must include the following:**

- 1. A completed scholarship application form**
- 2. An official recent transcript**
- 3. Two letters of recommendations on school letterhead in sealed envelopes with the signature across the seal. One letter must be from a teacher in your area of interest, and one from another school official who knows about your general character**
- 4. A copy of your SAT or ACT scores**
- 5. Write a short essay (one page - single spaced) explaining your educational/career goals and how you will strive to make a significant difference in our global society.**
- 6. Include recent wallet size photo of applicant**
- 7. The complete application packet must be received by March 3, 2017.**
- 8. Be available to come for a scheduled interview**
